Deadline for applications is 31 October 2017

Parents and carers of Year 6 children can now apply for places at secondary school for 2018 entry.

The deadline for receipt of completed applications is 31 October 2017.

Any applications received after this date are likely to be considered late, and will have a far less likely chance of securing a place at their preferred secondary school. Parents and carers should be encouraged to apply online at

www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/secondaryadmissions as this is the quickest and most secure way to apply.

Parking

It has been brought to my attention that there are still a small number of parents who are parking inconsiderately and sometime illegally in and around the school grounds.
Could I remind you of the school rules regarding parking.

1. Please **DO NOT** park in the staff car park, the bus bay or the approach road to the school. This area should only be used by approved school providers
(School Taxi and Dashwood afterschool club ONLY)
2. Do not park in the road between the school gates and the T junction at the top of Avocet Way. A number of you as parents have come in and expressed your concerns regarding this and we would like to do everything we can to make sure the children are safe.
3. Park considerately if you are parking in the side streets around the school. We have received several complaints about cars blocking driveways around Kingfisher Drive. We appreciate it is busy around school drop off and pick up times but please consider our neighbours. I have taken some pictures outlining the areas we would like kept clear so the children can walk to and from school safely.
Please could I ask you follow the rules and keep these areas clear and safe for your children.
