

A gentle reminder about uniform....

Thank you to all parents who make sure their children are in the proper school uniform. We are really proud of the school uniform and expect all children to wear it. We have noticed increasing numbers of children who are not wearing correct school uniform—mainly this is children forgetting what's allowed and what isn't. It's important for all children to wear practical, sensible and safe clothing. We expect all children to wear school uniform as follows:

All pupils are expected to wear uniform.

It consists of a navy blue pullover or cardigan and sky blue polo shirt with St John's School Logo.

Girls:

Girls may wear a navy blue pinafore dress, skirt or trousers with white or navy blue socks or navy blue tights.

In the summer girls may wear a blue gingham dress/playsuit.

Boys:

Boys may wear grey trousers or shorts with grey or black socks.

All pupils should have a pair of black indoor shoes (comfortable plimsolls or pumps with enclosed toes and heels) and a pair of black outdoor shoes (trainers are not allowed).

Nail vanish should not to be worn in school.

Pupils can wear one pair of stud earrings but these must be covered with tape or not worn for P.E. sessions.

No other jewellery should be worn.

Hair accessories should be kept minimal (**No JoJo Bows**)

Girls should not be wearing leggings under their skirts.
